Letter from our Founding Artistic Director



Dear Friends and Colleagues,

<u>April 28th</u>: <u>BOUNCE: An Opera in 4 Quarters</u>, came into being with our first team meeting: **Daniel Bernard Roumain** (DBR) on Music, **Charles R Smith** on Story & Libretto, **Torrie Allen** as Producer, **Chidi Ozieh** on Media, and yours truly Directing both the project and on the court! Stay tuned for more news in the Summer newsletter.

May 1st: One year and two weeks in the making, across borders, languages, continents and cultures, *The Three Astronauts* opera has its libretto! What governments find impossible, our artists found simulating, inspiring, and fun. Bravo **Daniel L Everett**, **Dmitry Glukhovsky**, **Liu Sola**, and **Yusef Komunyakaa**. Now being translated into Chinese and Russian, the libretto will soon be in the hands of **Ye Xiaogang** (China) and **Alexander Tchaykovskiy** (Russia), ready to spin their musical magic. Next up - to uncover the American Composer!

<u>May 14th</u>: I reconvene in Milan with **Eugenio Carmi**, the creator of the delicate yet vibrant collages that bring this book - and opera - to life: *I Tre Cosmonauti*. The opening of his exhibition at Kasa Dei Libri, will show the world the art work of three collaborative book projects Eugenio has made with revered author, **Umberto Eco**. Hoping we might be able to bring this to New York.

May 18th: Ardea Arts music director and composer **David Wolfson** and I meet up with **Dan Everett** in Bentley Massachusetts - the first step in transcribing a Martian language onto the musical staff. A language so tonal that we predict we will not need a Martian composer!!

A welcome to new staff member **Michelle Eliza**. Michelle will be project manager of BOUNCE, as well as assist with day to day administration. We expect this bright young dynamo to bring fresh ideas to the table.

July 9th: Thank you all for your continuing support, I look forward to continuing our collaborations and discussions.
