

Reading, testing and revisions of the libretto by Yusef Komunyakaa (USA), Liu Sola (CHINA), Dmitry Glukhovsky (RUSSIA), Daniel L Everett (MARS), and Grethe Barrett Holby (MISSION CONTROL), are complete, and Ardea Arts is ready to pass the baton on to the three composers who will begin the next leg of this international, intergalactic mission into unknown, alien territory!

Grethe flew over to Milan to review the libretto with 94 year old artist Eugenio Carmi, and author Umberto Eco, who together created the book on which the opera is based, and to attend the opening of an exhibition of three such collaborations between these two revered Italian artists. The exhibition was curated by Andrea Kerbaker at Kasa Dei Libre, an intimate, not-to-be-missed private librarygallery in Milan. The crowd was buzzing, the press was there interviewing, and the opera mentioned many times.

Three Astronauts' Russian writer, **Dmitry** Glukhovsky, flew down from Moscow to work with Holby on revisions of the libretto, and meet Eco and Carmi. As it turned out, Eco had a sudden health emergency, but unforgettable

times were spent with Eugenio Carmi, including visits to his studio, signing gorgeous prints, on archival watercolor paper from the book to help raise money for the opera, and sharing delicious Italian meals with Carmi's friends and family.
