Smith Jr., the composer and librettist, respectively, for BOUNCE, with the help of Shay Berry, head coach of men's basketball at CUNY Hunter College, and his student athletes, Lester Anim and Ishmael Nauserdeen. We worked with about 50 kids ages 8-16 from the community, teaching them music terms such as forte, vivace, and moderato. The kids also created their own poetry, utilizing Charles's original piece, "B-Ball Be," and discussed the importance of self expression and sharing thoughts and emotions through art. This October, Ardea Arts took *The Three Astronauts* to Las Cruces, New Mexico to present the first tastes of the opera at the Rio Grande Theater, in partnership with the Dona Ana Arts Council, on the 14th, and the International Symposium for Personal and Commercial Space (ISPCS) on the 15th.

The performances featured Donovan Singletary as the American astronaut, Jia-Jun Hong as the Chinese astronaut, Jessica Medoff as the Russian as the Russian astronaut, Jodn Carlo Pierce as Mission Control, four-time award winning ABC News reporter Sam Donaldson as himself and Mikhail Hallak on Piano.

The shows went off without a hitch! Members of the space community who attended ISPCS were astounded, and many recorded the performance using their cell phones.
